NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020*.
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The Green Island Race is open to all sail boats.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the application and sending it, together with the required fee, proof of liability insurance and LMPHRF certification to SBYC 600 Nautical Drive Sturgeon Bay, WI 54235 by Sept 6th, 2019.
- 3.3 Entries will be accepted at the registration desk at the SBYC Friday Sept 6th from 1800 to 2000. Registration also accepted by email to SeeGriff@gmail.com, Fees can be paid Saturday before the race. Yachts failing to sign in may not be scored at the discretion of the race committee.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows: \$20

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration: Sept. 6, 2019 From 18:00 To 20:00
- 5.2 **Sept 6th, the bar and restaurant will open at 17:30.**
- 5.3 Skippers meeting will be at the lounge at Harbor Club Marina at 08:30 Sept.7th. You will be able to get your start time Friday night.
- 5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first boat is Sept 7th, 2019 09:55.
- 5.5 **There will be a gathering on C dock at Harbor Club Marina following the race.**

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid rating certificate. Boats without current cert will be scored per the boats base rating.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 18:00 on sept. 6th at SBYC or at the Skipper meeting.

8 VENUE

8.1 The race shall take place on the waters of Green Bay.

9 THE COURSE

9.1 The course to be sailed will be as follows: Staggered start at buoys 31 – 32 in the Sturgeon Bay channel, Safe water buoy to port, Sherwood Point Shoals (aka Larsons Reef) to starboard, R2 at the southeast side of Green Island to starboard, Monument Shoals buoy to starboard and finish back at 31-32 in the Sturgeon Bay channel.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 The Scoring Penalty, rule 44.1, will apply.

11 SCORING

11.1 The scoring system is as follows: Boats will start based on corrected time. The order in which the boats finish will determine the winner.

12 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the race.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. All boats should monitor channel 69.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: prizes may be awarded at the C dock gathering after the race or at the banquet in October.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.
