

NOTICE OF RACE

HARRY F. PURINTON MEMORIAL RACE, June 8, 2019

STURGEON BAY YACHT CLUB, STURGEON BAY, WI

1. The Race will be governed by the rules as defined in **The Racing Rules of Sailing**.

2. Eligibility:

2.1 The H.F.P. Memorial Race is open to all LMPHRF and cruising yachts that meet U.S. Sailing qualifications.

2.2 Eligible yachts may enter by submitting the following:

a. A completed Entry Form and current certificate of liability insurance.

b. A valid LMPHRF certificate. (Yachts without a current LMPHRF certificate will be allowed to enter and will race using their base PHRF rating or a rating decided by the RC)

2.3 Completed entries will be accepted at one of the following locations, on or before June 7, 2019, 20:00.

a. If entering by U.S. Mail or hand delivering;

3. Fees: \$20

3.1 Course: Staggered start between buoys 31 and 32 in the Sturgeon Bay Channel, then to the safe water buoy to port, then to Sherwood Point Shoals (aka Larsen's reef) buoy leaving to starboard, then to Monument Shoal buoy leaving to port, then to 'R2A' off of M&M leaving to port with a finish off of the M&M break wall and a pin. 21.4 NM.

4 Sign In and Later Entries.

4.1 Friday June 7, 2019, 1800 to 2000 hrs Central Time.

The boat's owner, or an owner's representative, shall sign-in at the Bar/Registration Desk in the Sturgeon Bay Yacht Club. Yachts failing to sign-in may not be scored at the discretion of the Race Committee.

4.2 Race: Saturday June 8, 2019 09:00 hrs, Skippers meeting and weather briefing at "A" dock outer wall of the Harbor Club Marina (Sonny's).

Saturday June 8, 2019 10:00 hrs, first boat starts. There will be a staggered start, times will be determined at skippers meeting. Start times taken from GPS.

5. Measurement

5.1 Yachts without a valid LMPHRF will be rated by a measurer appointed by the race chair.

6. Sailing Instructions will be posted on the board at the SBYC and distributed to all yachts that have completed registration.

7. The Racing Area will be the waters of Green Bay.

8. The Race will be scored by corrected time, based on course sailed. Time allowances will be based on time and on distance expressed in nautical miles.

9. Penalties will be assessed in accordance with **The Racing Rules of Sailing**, including published revisions.

10. Prizes: To be determined.

12. Safety Equipment: Yachts shall comply with current US Coast Guard regulations.
